Tony Alderson joined WSP as the Carbon Capture and Storage (CCS) Technical Lead in December 2012. He holds a BEng in Chemical Engineering, a BA in Politics, Philosophy and Economics and is a Chartered Chemical Engineer. Tony has experience in the provision of engineering design, technical support and specialist consultancy services to the upstream and midstream hydrocarbons and energy sectors. He has expertise in carbon capture, utilisation & storage, hydrogen production & storage technologies, liquefied natural gas, gasification, Fischer-Tropsch Synthesis/gas to liquids and industrial decarbonisation.



Tony's expertise in CCS and hydrogen technology is widely recognised; he is a board member of the UK CCS Research Centre, a member of the BSI CCS Committee and ISO CO2 Capture Working Group, represents WSP in the Decarbonised Gas Alliance and has numerous publications and presentations.

### Sharon Gayter



Sharon has been a serious runner for 25 years, 18 of those at an international standard, representing Great Britain in events including the 100km and 24 hours. She has won many medals, ran in many countries and has broken multiple world records.

Sharon has ran across countries, deserts, mountains, roads and has even competed in track races. Running over 1700 races has taken her to the highest, hardest and hottest races in the world. As a veteran Sharon still has goals and ambitions, and is still able to break world records - the most recent being the fastest woman to travel by foot from John O'Groats to Land's End in 2019 at the age of 55.

Sharon's talk will offer an insight into how she became a world record breaking runner and will include her experiences of extreme running and of the highs and lows of infamous route - JOGLE. She will share the key to her successes which include leadership, commitment, overcoming obstacles and fighting the clock!
