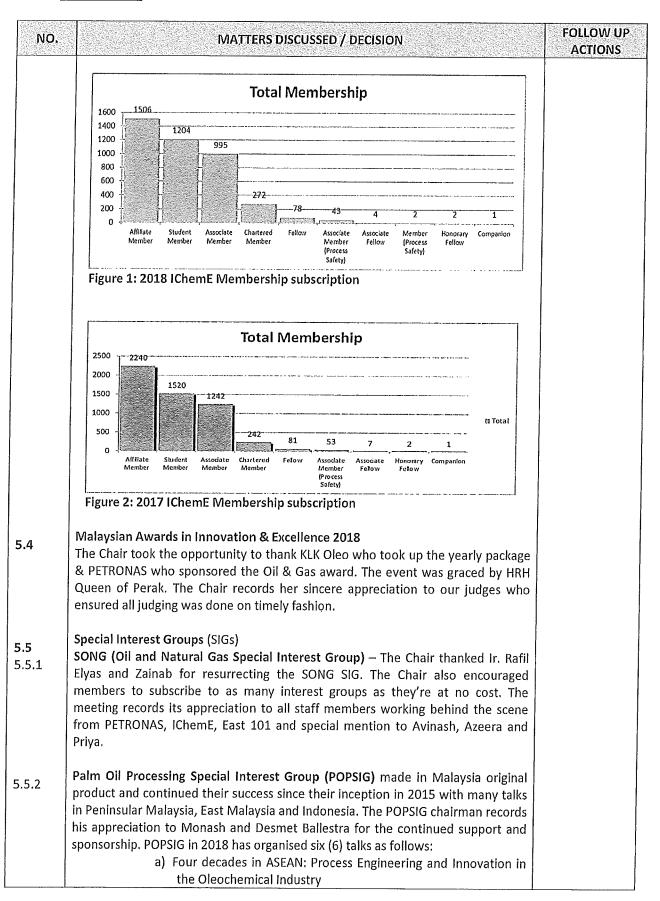

1.	OPENING REMARKS BY THE CHAIR	
1.1	The Chair thanked Prof Chan Eng Seng and team for hosting 13 th IChemE AGM at Monash University and welcomed all members to the Annual General Meeting 2019.	
1.2	The meeting started with a safety briefing by Mr. Balaram Nair of Monash University Malaysia Campus.	
1.3	The Chair, in her opening remarks, highlighted that IChemE Malaysia had overall improved in activities and financial position in 2018.

2.1	The agenda was adopted without any amendments (attached as per Appendix 2).	
3	CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES FROM 11th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2017	
3.1	Minutes of the 12 th Annual General Meeting, held on 11 March 2018, were accepted. Proposed by Poh Phaik Eong and seconded by Dr Ragunath Bharath.	
4.	MATTERS ARISING FROM 12th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2017	
4.1	There were no matters arising from the previous meeting that are not included in other parts of this meeting.	
5.	REPORTING OF THE ICHEME BOARD ANNUAL REPORT 2018	
5.1	The Chair presented the Board's Annual Report for 2018. A summary report of	



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	2018 is as follows:		
	 a) The Special Interest Group (SIG) also performed well. A special mention to our continued POP SIG members for their active level of participation. b) HRH Tuanku Zara Salim graced the IChemE Malaysia Awards 2018 		
	and she has agreed to grace the same event in 2019. c) Highlights of 2018 on Training and Events: i) Regional Palm Oil Processing Seminar (with 80 attendees);		
	ii) SOMChE (with 70 attendees); iii) Awards Dinner with 200 attendees; and iv) Successful outcome on Training Programmes.		
5.1.1	The meeting records its sincere appreciation to all members who make a significant contribution to IChemE Malaysia on a voluntary basis.		
5.2 5.2.1	Staff Professor Michael Cloke finished his assignment as Director of South East Asia and the Board records its appreciation for his tremendous work. Peter Slane took on the role of Director of Asia Pacific beginning March 2018.		
5.2.2	In addition to the above, Hayati Rejab was replaced by Dharshani Ravindran Naidu as Finance and Administrative Assistant, and Mohan Balasingam role is more focused in Business Development Manager, SE Asia for Events, Training and Membership Development. His specific responsibilities include planning and marketing of IChemE training courses, events, conferences, etc., mostly in Malaysia.		
5.2.3	Lojini Soomaran (Tharshinye) started with IChemE Malaysia as Office Manager effective 1 March 2018 and her role is in handling Board matters, Finance, Registrar of Society (ROS), tax assessment and oversee other operational matters.		
5.2.4	The meeting was further informed that only two staff as Membership and Customer Service Administrator namely Norazerina Rejab and Amir Aiman in the KL office. These are Global role dealing with all new memberships, transfer of membership and member customer service for IChemE. It was noted that about 90% of the staff charges for the Global Staff is re-charged back to the UK.		
5.2.5	Two Global team namely; ICE and IMechE continued collaboration.		
5.3 5.3.1	Membership The change in overall membership in Malaysia from 2017 to 2018 was from 5388 to 4107. These statistics are based on the exclusion of one-year arrears "members" from the membership total. The overall Chartered members increased by 29 in 2018 which reads as 352 Chartered Members, which includes 78 Fellows. Please refer to the given chart below:

5.5.3	The meeting acknowledged that BESIG in Malaysia is headed by Dr Edward Ooi who took over from Dr Ramanan after the BESIG AGM around April. The SIG organises BESIG Research Talk on Endocytic movement of membrane: studies of both model and actual cell membranes, Development of next generation platforms for the production of bio-therapeutics and animal vaccines in E.coli, Development of microbial cell factories for consolidated bioprocessing by synthetic bioengineering platform and Microalgae as a platform for biofuels production and circular economy	
5.5.4	The meeting noted that Education Special Interest Group (EDUSIG) organises Dynamic Simulation Workshop.	
5.6 5.6.1	Seminars 31st Symposium of Malaysian Chemical Engineers (SOMChE) jointly organized by University Putra Malaysia and IChemE from 5 – 6 December 2018. The theme was "Innovative thought for chemical engineering practise" was successful in drawing speakers from Asia and the number of participants was 90.	
5.6.2	National Chemical Engineering Symposium (NACES) organised by the Chemical Technology Students Society (CTSS), University Kuala Lumpur Malaysian Institute of Chemical and Bioengineering Technology (UniKL MICET), Malacca.	
5.6.3	Regional Palm Oil Processing Seminar (RPOPS) – Value addition in the palm oil downstream sector organised by the POP SIG committee led by UR Unnithan. The event was successful. The committee provided great input & managed to attract 80 participants.	
5.6.4	It was noted that the following training courses had been organized in 2018: Inherent Safety, 18-19 April 2018 HAZOP Study for Team Members & Team Leaders, 26-30 July 2018 Fundamental of Process Safety, 26-30 November 2018	
6.	YEAR-END ACCOUNT 2018	
	Zainab Kayat FIChemE tabled the year-end accounts for 2018. These were audited in the UK but not by the locally elected Honorary Auditors in Malaysia.	
	The financial standing of the Branch recorded a net surplus of RM 434,600 in 2018, compared to a net surplus of RM 128,009 in 2017. The surplus in 2018	



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	comprises agreed recovery of historical costs of RM 264,028, placed on the Malaysia Branch Account by IChemE UK. The remaining surplus of RM 170,572 is attributable to overall cost reduction for staff and TCE charges and an increase in revenue from subscriptions. Cash position has improved for Malaysia Branch following the implementation in 2017 of proper arrangements of recharges for global staff salary, overheads, TCE, IMechE and ICE. This was further clarified by Prof Michael Cloke.			
6.3	Ir Razmahwata Bin Mohd Razali was nominated, as he was not nominated before for Honorary Auditor 2018/2019. Proposed by Ir Dr Christina Phang and seconded by Prof Law Chung Lim. The year-end accounts 2018 were then signed by Honorary Auditors 2018/2019 namely; David Hassell and Ir Razmahwata Bin Mohd Razali.			
6.4	It was noted that the year-end accounts will be submitted to the Registrar of Society sixty-days from the date of AGM.	IChemE Malaysia		
6.5	The Chair informed that the Intercompany transfer of MYR100,000 to UK to be deliberated at the next Board Meeting for decision.			
6.6	Institut Jurutera Kimia Malaysia (IJKM) fund of MYR65,000 for student chapter activity. The IChemE Board 2018/2019 decided to keep this fund running and encouraged student chapters to apply. For further details to get in touch with the IChemE office directly.			
6.7	Year-end accounts 2018 was amended with approval. Proposed by Paul Ellis and seconded by Dr Azlan Shah bin Hussain.			
7.	CONSTITUTION AMENDMENTS	IChemE

7.2	AGM noted that its Constitution of 2017 requires a full review in line of the change in the IChemE governance.
