| $\mathbf{1 . 0}$ | Presentation <br> The AGM was preceded by a presentation by Professor Tom Baxter, on an alternative <br> view on Carbon Capture. This included an overview of the parasitic loads within the <br> CO2 extraction process, that effectively mean that additional fossil fuel must then be <br> burned to achieve the same power generation load prior to modification of the system. <br> This ultimately increases discharges of NOx, SOx and particulates. Challenge made that <br> efforts would be better spent in other areas, good examples were given such as home <br> energy efficiency and a case study of process optimisation in gas compression train to <br> reduce the power demand of the system. This sparked some really good debate and <br> the suggestion that we hold a follow-on event to look at other sides of the debate. Our <br> thanks goes to Tom for presenting. |  |
