Reasons for nomination.

Please ensure you cover the following specific areas when answering as the nomination will be judged against the criteria as listed below:

1. Scientific advance – significantly moving the state of the art on specific topic
2. Scope and significance – demonstrated huge potential in terms of application of methods and tools to solving unsolved-challenging problems
3. Significance of impact – already widely used within and outside the particle technology community
4. Patents or publications and citations on a specific topic – pioneered or advanced a topic; motivated others to follow; established a new area of research

Be succinct but do include sufficient relevant information for the judges to evaluate the nomination. Judges are not expected to go and research candidates beyond what the nominator has written.
