Please ensure you cover the following specific areas when answering as the nomination will be judged against the criteria as listed below:

The Hanson Medal focuses on non-technical papers with the key criteria for the medal being 'promoting chemical engineering and promoting discussion'. Staff writers and freelances are excluded from the award. The definition of the medal and criteria it will be judged against are deliberately left imprecise to enable those assessing to select and recommend on any basis they choose.

Be succinct but do include sufficient relevant information for the judges to evaluate the nomination. Judges are not expected to go and research candidates beyond what the nominator has written.
