## Frequently asked questions

	Question	Response
1.	Do I need to fill up any registration form? How many forms should I complete?	Only 1 online form needs to be submitted.
2.	When should I fill up the online form?	Complete the online form when you submit your infographic design.
3.	Do I need to pay to participate in this competition?	No. It is free of charge to all eligible students.
4.	I saw a poster showing that the registration fee to attend IPOSC 2022 is RM500. Isn't the IPOSC 2022 Infographic Competition free of charge?	Yes, IPOSC 2022 Infographic Competition is free of charge. The registration fee to attend IPOSC 2022 (conference) on 13 Sep 2022 is RM500 – this is open for the public to register.
5.	My student status (or student ID) expires on 26 August 2022. Can I still participate?	Yes. You are eligible to participate if you submit your infographic by the evening of 26 August 2022.
6.	There is no expiry date on my ID card, and I just completed my final year exam in July 2022. Am I eligible to participate?	Yes, you are eligible to participate in this competition.
7.	My student ID tells I am a registered student in 2021/2022 session. Am I eligible to participate?	Yes, you are eligible to participate in this competition.
8.	I just completed my Year 4 final examination and is currently waiting for the results. Am I eligible to participate?	Yes, you are eligible to participate in this competition.

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9.	I obtained my Year 4 final examination results and is currently waiting for graduation ceremony in September 2022. Am I eligible to participate?	Yes, you are eligible to participate in this competition.
10.	I have completed my graduation ceremony in July 2022, but I am not yet employed. Am I eligible to participate?	No. It means you have graduated from your university and is no longer eligible for this competition.
11.	My team consists of one BEng Year 2 student and one MSc student. Is our team eligible to participate?	Yes. There are no restrictions on team formation, provided that all are students.
12.	Is there any specification on referencing style?	It is recommended to use numbered referencing style.
13.	Can I include a QR code to direct the reader to the reference list?	Yes. You can.
14.	Which group of audience should my infographic to be designed for?	Your infographic should be designed to be studied by the public.
15.	Do I need introduction, objectives, conclusion etc for this infographic design?	They are not necessary. It is not restricted to be an academic poster. We welcome innovative design.
16.	Do I need to include IPOSC, POPSIG and MPOC logos on my design?	Yes, it is mandatory. They will be provided by POPSIG on an online shared Drive. Please use properly. No reference to the logos is needed.
17.	How should I arrange the organisers' logo on my design?	From left to right: IPOSC 2022, POPSIG, MPOC. A guideline has been provided on Dropbox folder.
18.	Where can I find/ download IPOSC, POPSIG and MPOC logos?	Please click "Guidelines & instructions" link on top of Page 1 in this document.
19.	Can I include my faculty/department logo on the infographic?	Yes. Faculty/department/university logos are optional to be included.
20.	Can I have my own topic that aligns to the theme stated?	Yes. Every infographic needs a title. Please create a title that aligns with your content.
21.	Must the content be all about chemical engineering?	No. The content can be about any disciplines.
22.	I am doing my MSc in Pharmacology. Would my content about cancer biology be accepted for submission?	Yes. The content can be about any discipline and field of study related to Malaysian palm oil and its contribution to SDGs.

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23.	What are the SDG goals?	You can check the UN SDGs website at: <u>https://sdgs.un.org/goals</u>
24.	There are 17 SDGs. Should I discuss all of them?	No. Pick at least one SDG goal for your content.
25.	Must the content be relevant to the past POPSIG webinars and roadshows?	No. The content can be independent of the past POPSIG events.
26.	Do I need to include my contact details on my infographic?	No. It only requires IPOSC 2022, POPSIG and MPOC logos, participants' name, their department, and university only.
27.	Is there any minimum font size required for the design?	No. It is important to make the content legible, including graphic, image and fonts.
28.	Must my content cover the area on what the Malaysian palm oil industry has contributed towards Malaysia's SDGs?	Yes. This is the mandatory element.
29.	Must my content cover the area on how the Malaysian palm oil industry can contribute towards Malaysia's SDGs?	It is not mandatory, but recommended element to be included. This will also be counted towards the final score.
30.	Can I split the content into two separate infographics? One about what MPO industry has contributed, and the second one about how it can contribute towards Malaysia's SDGs.	Every infographic must describe what the Malaysian palm oil industry has contributed towards Malaysia's SDGs.
31.	After online submission, do I need to post a printed copy to POPSIG?	No. Only online submission is required.
32.	How does the total number of "like" on social media be counted?	Please see the formula:   How to calculate the total number of "like" on social media:   Team Member 1 Team Member 2 Team Member 3   Facebook a c e   Instagram b d f   TOTAL NUMBER OF "LIKE" = <b>a + b + c + d + e + f = FINAL</b> *Judge will only calculate one post on each member's social media.   Please use "Share" feature on Facebook, and "Stories" on Instagram
33.	When will the total number of "like" on social media be counted?	The judges will record the sum at 09:00 MYT, 2 September 2022. Total number of "like" from each team member's social media account (FB+IG) will be recorded.
34.	Can one team member make multiple post of the same graphic on the same social media?	The judges will only count one (1) post of each team member on each social media.

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35.	I make two (2) submissions of different infographics. Should I post separately or two infographics together in one post on Instagram?	One post must only contain one infographic. This will avoid any miscounting.
36.	Will my infographic be evaluated during IPOSC 2022 conference on 13 September 2022?	No. All evaluations will complete by Friday 2 September 2022.
37.	Do I need to make a presentation about my infographic?	No. Only online submission is required.
38.	How would I be informed about the outcome?	The results will first be informed by email to the contestants, followed by the announcements on IChemE website and social media.
39.	If I were one of the winners, what would I have to do during IPOSC 2022 conference in KL?	Besides the award ceremony, you will attend the conference with a series of presentations delivered by Malaysian and foreign speakers from 9:00am to 5:30pm.
40.	If I were one of the winners, do I have to bring a printed copy of my infographic to the conference/ ceremony?	No. You do not need to do any printing for this competition/ ceremony.
41.	Could I know the specific prizes for winners?	Visit the information webpage (as shown in Page 1) and view the full details in online PDF.
42.	Does one of my team's supervisors/ lecturers get a complimentary entry pass to IPOSC 2022 conference on 13 September?	If you sought consultation with your lecturer about the content/design, then the organiser provides one complimentary entry pass to one lecturer of each awarded (Top 10) team.
43.	Is it mandatory for my lecturer to attend IPOSC 2022 conference?	No. This is optional to the lecturer.
44.	What should I do on 13 September 2022?	The winning teams will be informed by email.
