Call for Contributions

This one-day symposium aims to showcase new developments and promote interactions within the fluid separations community. We welcome contributions from PhD students and early-career academic and industrial researchers working in areas relevant to the engineering of fluid separations. Come and tell members of the community about your innovative work on separation processes – from distillation, absorption and extraction, to adsorption, membrane separations, filtration, and chromatography. Share how your work on separation and bioprocess technologies contributes to sustainable processes and products, for example, involving CO₂ capture, ammonia, hydrogen or methane production, or advanced storage solutions.

Researchers selected to contribute will be invited to give a 20–25 minute presentation to an audience from industry and academia, including other early-career researchers. Experienced members from industry and academia will evaluate the presentations and give general feedback. The event will give participants a chance to discover diverse and exciting current research work, and will provide opportunities for networking and discussions during coffee breaks and over lunch. The event will close with a celebratory networking gathering where prizes totalling up to £600 will be awarded for the best presentations by IChemE members. IChemE members who present their work, and whose travel (with the minimum feasible rail fare) from their university town to Rugby costs over £25, may claim up to £100 towards their travel costs from IChemE.
