



Technical and **vocational** education

- Apprenticeships combine on-the-job training with formal learning that builds skills, competence and capability. Suitable for new and existing staff.
- T Levels (England) two-year qualifications for 16–19 year-olds, combining classroom learning with a 45-day industry placement. Equip students with practical skills for the workplace. (Equivalent pathways available in Scotland, Wales, and Northern Ireland.)
- Higher Technical Qualifications (HTQs) Level 4 or 5 courses, known as Higher National Certificates and Higher National Diplomas, develop skills for technical roles, career progression, or further study. (Recognised as SCQF Levels 7 and 8 in Scotland.)

IChemE offers impartial advice and tailored support to help Employer Partners explore how technical and vocational routes can align with their workforce strategies and operational goals.
