

Primary School Outreach Volunteer

Volunteer Role Descriptor

1. Introduction

All young children love stories, especially when someone is reading to them, but not all young children have an interest in engineering or even know what it is. We are looking for dynamic chemical engineers who will be willing to support ongoing IChemE engagement in primary schools, for children aged 5 to 11 years old. This is an accessible way to share your career with young children and to open a discussion about their future aspirations.

2. What you will be doing

Using resources and story books provided, you will:

- identify a local primary school for your outreach visit
- make contact with the school to arrange your visit
- visit the school to read a story to the children
- run a short activity that links to the story, such as discussing environmental issues with the children
- explain what you do in your engineering career

Do I need to have a school already in mind?

Ideally yes. Think about any schools you may already have a connection with: perhaps as a governor or through family and friends with children at the school.

Resources to help you prepare for your visit, run activities and story books, written by [The3Engineers](#), will be provided.

3. About you

You will need to be:

- a chemical engineer or a chemical engineering student
- be a member (any grade) of the Institution

Do I need to be DBS checked? It is not essential, as you will not be working alone with the children and the school will advise you about any school specific requirements.

4. How you will benefit

There are many benefits to volunteering in this role, including:

- supporting your local community and school(s)
- personal satisfaction that your contribution helps to support and inspire future chemical engineers

5. Time commitment

A single visit to a school would take a maximum of 2 hours (plus travel time). Alternatively, you can choose to visit one school on a regular basis, or a number of schools depending on your availability.

6. Period of appointment

This role is available on an ongoing basis.

7. How to apply & appointment method

Please apply using the “apply now” button on this advert on the website. The volunteering team will be in contact with further information.

We will contact all applicants and provide further information on induction and training.

If this opportunity is of interest but you are not available this time, please get in touch to register your interest as we hope to have similar opportunities in the future.

8. Induction & training

You will be provided with information on IChemE’s GDPR guidelines and be required to read and understand our safeguarding guidance.

We will confirm details via email and provide a pack of resources for you to use.
