1. Introduction

The Audit and Risk Committee provide high level oversight to ensure adequate control arrangements are in place to support management and provide assurance to the Board of Trustees. This work is distinct from the executive management of the Institution. The Committee has a key role in the effective governance of the Institution ensuring there is effective risk management, internal controls and external and internal audit.

2. What you will be doing

The purpose of the Audit & Risk Committee is to assess the effectiveness of risk management and internal control across the organisation, reporting to and advising the Board of Trustees. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Review the fundamental risks facing the organisation and ensure controls are in place to manage those risks
- Review compliance with internal controls, policies, procedures and committees with terms of references
- Oversee the appointment, independence, and rotation of external auditors
- Agree scope of the external audits and meet with external auditors to review audit findings

- Current voting member (Fellow, Chartered or Associate grade)
- Knowledge or experience of risk management and oversight
- Understanding of internal controls and financial systems
- Ability to analyse complex information and reach a decision
- Knowledge or experience of audit and auditing practices, internally and externally
- Understanding of charity governance and experience in operation of branches and subsidiaries
- Strong communication skills
- Maintain strict confidentiality regarding sensitive information
