### What

DiscoverChemEngLIVE is a free STEM event showcasing careers in chemical and process engineering, helping schools and colleges meet Gatsby Benchmarks by connecting young people with local employers and real-world innovation. The interactive exhibition features leading companies, universities and hands-on activities, with opportunities for students to speak directly to working engineers.

### Who

School and college pupils aged 12 to 18-year-old (y8-y13)

Group size of up to 30 young people, plus teaching and/or support staff

### Getting here/ parking

We encourage local schools to walk, use the train (we are located 5 mins walk from Rugby station). Limited minibus parking available on site, please pre-book a space with us. Larger coaches cannot access the car park but can drop off/ pick up on Pinders Lane.

### First Aid

- First aiders will be available on site.

### Risk assessments

- A site risk assessment will be provided in advance. Individual risk assessments for activities will also be provided.

### Visiting IChemE offices

- There is no provision for lunch onsite.
- No school bags, food, or drink bottles are permitted on site (water will be provided if needed).
- Teaching staff are asked to be aware that whilst IChemE Engagement staff are DBS checked, the exhibitors are not (although safeguarding guidance will be issued) and as such, young people must remain under the supervision of their school or college staff throughout the event, even when they are exploring the exhibition area independently.
- Young people are the responsibility of their school or college staff throughout the event, even when they are exploring the exhibition area independently. Including safeguarding, behaviour, and emergency evacuation.

- We will confirm the number of young people and teaching/support staff in your group before the event. Numbers must not be increased without asking us first. If your number decreases, please also let us know so that your spaces can be reallocated.

## Film and photography

- Film and photography of young people will be captured at DiscoverChemEngLIVE at the Institution of Chemical Engineers. This will be used for editorial purposes and marketing of future events. IChemE staff will assume that permission forms have been returned for all visitors (It is the responsibility of accompanying teaching staff to ensure that permission forms are completed and returned to IChemE).
- Close-up shots of any individuals will not be captured; it is the responsibility of accompanying teachers to ensure that any child (or accompanying adult) who cannot be photographed is clearly identified to reception staff on arrival (they will be given a coloured sticker which must be clearly visible on their person).
- The IChemE takes no responsibility for the video and photographic capture of any individuals whose 'no-photography' identifiers are not clearly displayed.
