Extract from IChemE By-Laws

Nominations and Ballot for Election to the Honorary Offices and the Council

67. Not later than eleven weeks before each Annual General Meeting the Council shall send to each voting member entitled to vote a list of the retiring Honorary Officers of the Institution and retiring ordinary members of the Council and a list of duly qualified persons whom the Council (with the consent of such persons respectively) nominate as candidates for the vacancies existing or about to occur in the Honorary Offices respectively and among the ordinary members of Council.
68. Any two voting members may nominate any duly qualified person as a candidate for any such vacancy (among the ordinary members of the Council) by delivering to the chief executive within three weeks after the date of dispatch of the list mentioned in the immediately preceding By-law hereof a nomination in writing duly signed by the nominators together with the written consent to act if elected of the person nominated but each such nominator shall be debarred from nominating any other person from the same election. No person shall be eligible to fill any vacancy by election at the Annual General Meeting pursuant to these By-laws unless nominated for the same in compliance with this By-law or the immediately preceding By-law.
